



Blue Orangery

SpacelabUK has completed a £550,000 pavilion for Great Ormond Street Hospital in west London.

The sculptural timber-and-glass "Orangery" provides a new dining hall for staff and patients at the hospital and can also be used for exhibitions and events. The pavilion replaces a simple picnic area on the roof of the boiler house in the hospital. The roof of the pavilion will be clad in zinc.

SpacelabUK says the distinctive roof and highly visible site have made the pavilion a talking point at the hospital, and it is being used as a tranquil alternative to the "chaos of the hospital wards".
